Mental Health Matters



At a time in our nation where mental ill-health is being talked about as an epidemic, we believe that the Church has a vital role in presenting a different narrative which is full of hope and the possibility of breakthrough. "Mental Health Matters" brings together biblical truth and psychology, personal stories and the power of the Holy Spirit.

This year's programme at Audacious Church in Manchester will include practical workshops on:

Young People's Emotional Health – Equipping parents, educators and youth workers to further understand and help the young people they are connected with.

Men's Emotional Health; busting the stereotype – A workshop speaking into the area of men's emotional health and well being (for men only).

Managing Stress; preventing burnout – A workshop focused on developing and maintaining your health and well being.

Getting to the root of the issue – Helping you understand how to address the root of the problem and not just the symptoms.

There will also be main sessions including praise and worship, encounter moments and times of prayer.

"Mental Health Matters" is for all ages from our young people upwards.

The day will run from 10.00am – 3.30pm and the cost for the day is £10 with concessions for under 18's, students and senior citizens at £8. A hot lunch will be provided.

We are believing for a great day together, where you will feel loved, supported and encouraged to encounter the God who is able to meet us where we are. **Everyone** is welcome.
